NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 The organizing authority (OA) is the Newport Harbor Yacht Club (NHYC).
- 1.3 *Alterations to the Rules* – For the Harbor 20 Class only, RRS 44.1 and 44.2 will be changed so that only one turn, including one tack and one gybe, is required.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all Lehman 12 and Harbor 20 boats.
- 2.2 The Lehman 12 and Harbor 20 fleets will sail in two divisions, A and B. Five boats will be required to entitle a class and/or division to its own start.
- 2.3 The L-12 "B" class will be allowed to sail single-handed, however boats and crews must still meet class-mandated weight requirements. Five boats will be required to entitle a class to its own start.
- 2.4 Eligible boats may enter online by completing the entry form at www.nhyc.org. There is no entry fee for this regatta.

4. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be available at the Newport Harbor Yacht Club on Sunday, April 13, 2008.

5. RACING AREA

All classes will be racing in the harbor north of the Main Dock of the Newport Harbor Yacht Club.

6. THE COURSES

The courses for all classes will be windward -leeward type courses or any variation of a triangular or other course.

7. SCORING

- 7.1 One (1) race is required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 7.2 When five (5) or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

8. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to during, or after the regatta.
